

## Snow Clearing at HWDSB Schools

HWDSB staff will clear, salt and/or sand walkways from the city sidewalk to the school, school steps and portable steps, walkways to portables, ramps to schools, and fire exit stairs and ramps.

<u>City of Hamilton is responsible for clearing snow and ice from sidewalks directly in front</u> <u>of schools which is a top priority for the city</u>. It may take up to 24 hours after a snowfall for sidewalks to be cleared. Report a sidewalk fronting a school in need of clearing at 905-546-2489.

HWDSB Contractors (after 5 cm of snow) will plow parking lots and sidewalks when HWDSB Facilities staff deem it necessary, salt and sand the parking lot before school starts, and if required, Head Caretakers may also salt or sand parking lots.

Playgrounds will be plowed or cleared up to half of the asphalt play area at schools by Contractors. Head Caretakers also inspect playgrounds and spot sand and/or salt significant icy areas.



This is a reminder that the parking lot is for <u>Staff Parking only</u>. This area is <u>NOT</u> for drop off or pick up of students, and students are <u>NOT</u> to be playing on the snow banks in the parking lot. Should you choose to drive your students to school, please park in designated parking spaces only. The bus loading zone in front of the school is also NOT for pick up or drop off. Parking enforcement is aware of these issues, and will be on site more frequently.

## **Kindergarten Registration**

Registration for kindergarten opened up on Friday, February 7, 2025. Families with children born in 2021 will be able to register on-line starting on that date. Once the registration has been reviewed, the school will reach out to each family to discuss any additional requirements that may be needed. As part of the registration process, the school will need to see either a passport or birth certificate for the student, as well as proof of address (CURRENT utility bill, mortage/lease agreement, property tax bill) with either parent name, and address. We will speak with each family to set up a time to come in to present this information.
