## Upcoming dates to be aware of:

**Spring Open House and Book Fair** ... our 'Spring Open House' (combined with Scholastic Book Fair) will take place on Wednesday, May 7<sup>th</sup> this year. Once again, as part of our event, the Greensville Optimists Community and Youth Foundation will be operating a **Food Trailer** out back on the tarmac from roughly **4:30 – 6:00**. The **Scholastic Book Fair** will be set up in the gym and this will be accessible for browsing/purchases as of 3:10 in the afternoon (upon dismissal). Any proceeds/profit from the sale of items comes back to the school by way of books for classrooms as well as for our school library.

**From 5:00 - 6:30 pm**, the doors out back will be opened for access to the school and families are welcome to come on in and tour (this time is not intended to be for student progress updates).

Families of Grade 3 students will receive additional details in the coming days.

**Kindergarten orientation** ... our orientation program for families new to FDK will be on Tuesday, May  $13^{th}$  from 6:00 - 7:00 pm. If you are aware of families intending to register children into our Kindergarten program for the fall, please encourage them to do so as more information will be shared out directly to those families registered.

**Community Engagement ('bEKind' Assemblies)** ... we continue to invite caregivers into the school to see and/or be part of these assemblies here at EK involving their children. For several years now, we have had an initiative in place that we refer to as 'bEKind' and we organize regular assemblies to recognize, teach, and celebrate 'kindness' as it pertains to students here at EK. Three have occurred already and two are still to come (see below).

Hosting these assemblies has always been shared between combinations of Grades FDK - 5 classes and this continues to be the case. We now invite caregivers of students in the participating 'host classes' to join us.

Our LAST 'bEKind' assembly this year is on:

**Choir Fest 2025** ... on Thursday, May 8<sup>th</sup> Mr. Popek will be taking choir students to the annual *HWDSB Choirfest*, which takes place Churchill Secondary School.

**Junior Track and Field** ... club practices began today (May 1<sup>st</sup>) for all interested students in Grades 3, 4 and 5. During these practices, students are also 'trying out' to be considered for the EK Track and Field Team. The Board wide meet is scheduled for Friday, June 20<sup>th</sup> and additional information will be shared out with interested and eligible students.

Front Garden revitalization ... by now you may have already seen a separate communication regarding this and as you may have noticed, the gardens in front of the school need some work! Unfortunately, landscaping such as what we're requiring is not managed by School Board staff (or by contractor) and so any upkeep becomes a school responsibility. In consultation with our School Council and local garden centres, we now have a reasonable plan (including costs) as well as several caregiver volunteers willing to help with the work. We've been able to access school budget money to cover a little over 60% of the total and we're looking for some help with the balance.
