Dear Parents/Guardians,

I am writing to let you know about a topic that affects your school. On Monday, June 17, 2013, Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board (HWDSB) Trustees decided to start an elementary accommodation review in our community. The *West Glanbrook Accommodation Review* will include the following schools:

Bell-Stone

Mount Hope

An accommodation review occurs after a school board considers the current and projected enrolment at a group of schools, as well as the current physical condition of the school(s) and repairs or upgrades required.

The goal of this process is to create innovative learning environments that support student achievement. Public consultation is a big part of this process. The review could result in recommendations including:

- The closure or consolidation of a school
- Changes to grades and programs offered at a school
- New facilities and/or upgrades
- School boundary changes
- Partnerships and/or joint use opportunities
- Status quo (no changes)

The first step in the process will be to create an advisory Accommodation Review Committee (ARC) in September 2013. HWDSB will assign a Superintendent to chair the committee. The ARC will also include members of School Council and/or Home and School, school administrators, school staff, parent representatives and Board Planning staff. More information will be sent home in September.
