Principle #1: Program offerings

- Infrastructure for specialty programs -
 - Art Room
 - Music Room
 - Science Labs
- Accommodations for exceptional students
- Programs for cognitive-needs
- French immersion





Principle #2: Transportation

- Efficient bus riding routes
- Reduced riding times for our students
- The 60-minute guideline seems to be stretched so the guideline should consider other factors that impede the bus staying well within the guideline (e.g. redirection around a country block)





Principle #3: Current school resources

- If students move to a different facility, the current resources should move with the students
 - Playground equipment
 - SmartBoards
 - Computer equipment
 - Science lab equipment
 - Library books
- Costs to cover installation and training of these resources should be included in recommendation





Principle #4: 21st learning environment

- Technology needs
- Learner needs
- Large collaboration spaces
- Adequate power-supply and internet connections
- Consideration for how class times overlap and timing of shared resources to ensure the proper quantity and quality of time (e.g. gyms, computer labs)
- Infrastructure and adequate shared spaces
