Help your child succeed in school: build the habit of good attendance early. School success

Did you know?

- Starting in kindergarten, too many absences can cause children to fall behind in school.
- Missing 10 percent (or about 18 days) can make it harder to learn to read.
- Students can still fall behind if they miss just a day or two every few weeks.
- Being late to school may lead to poor attendance.
- Absences can affect the whole classroom if the teacher has to slow down learning to help children catch up.

Attending school regularly helps children feel better about school - and themselves. Start building this habit in preschool so they learn right away that going to school on time, every day is important. Good attendance will help children do well in high school, college, and at work. HELP! PARENT VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!

Our school is in urgent need of parent volunteers to help with a variety of things like our snack program, pizza days and reading to students. If you are able to volunteer at all during the school day, please contact the office. Your help is greatly appreciated by our staff and students.

Parent volunteers also play an important role on our class trips as the HWDSB requires specific adult/child ratios (depending on the age of the students) for all off site excursions. If you are interested in volunteering for your child's class trip, you must have a police check. Police checks are only valid with the HWDSB for 3 years. If your police check is older than 1 year but less than 3, you are required to complete an Offence Declaration. Please contact the office for forms or questions.

Vulnerable Sector Police Checks for volunteers have a fee of \$25 and take 30 days to process.

Please note that teachers only need a certain number of volunteers and may not be able to accommodate all parents wanting to help with the trip due to cost and space on the bus.
