The following was an e-mail from Suzie and Leah, keeping Council up to date on happenings at FC:

"Item #1:

Mark and his promotional crew will start their class-to-class Cobs fundraiser kick off in the next few days. The money raised will support the Maker Space Room that Mark discussed at previous meetings with 15% of the profit being donated to Pauline Johnson. Since we have high hopes for this fundraiser, we are offering the following incentives to strongly encourage students to get behind it:

1. The student who raises the most money will receive a voucher for 1 free loaf of bread for 1 year (1 loaf/ week). 2. The class that raises the most money will receive a pizza party, as we have accumulated free pizzas with our Rewards points.

3. The runner-up class will also receive the same voucher as #1 (1 free loaf /week for a year), and the teacher can draw the name of any student who sold vouchers for their class.
