Hello all,

February is Report Card month. They will be handed out to students on Feb. 13th. As staff prepare reports here there are a few messages that we give from the office. "Be honest and direct about achievement." Do not confuse this being mean or negative. Staff are asked to report on exactly how your child is doing. It's not about good or bad. Remember that we are trying to summarize 5 months of work into a few sentences and in some cases only 1-2 sentences. "Pay attention to the learning skill section" I believe this is the most important area of the report card. It details how your child is progressing as a learner. These are the skills that create life long learners. They are also vital to successfully navigating the unprecedented volume of information that's readily available via the internet and all its sources. "What next steps could be taken?" This is expected for students who are achieving below the provincial standard of a "B". Staff are trying to give feedback in a sentence or two. This is not all of what we are doing. Please contact your child's teacher if you want further help. More homework (worksheets) is not the answer. Your child's teacher will have excellent suggestions of how you can support your learner. As always, after contacting your child's teacher first, if you still have concerns please do not hesitate to connect with myself or Mrs. Bosher.
