PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Hello Community,

We would like to extend our congratulations to the Senior Girls Basketball team, who won the City Championship last month and to the Gatestone Dance team for delivering outstanding routines at a competition in late March. As a reminder, Pizza sale and Milk money profits are used to subsidize trips throughout the year. Staff are planning year end trips now and we are covering transportation for these events from that money. Parent Council is using their fundraising dollars exploring Hydration stations for the 1st and 2nd floors. We will keep you up to date as we proceed with that project. We have a long stretch of learning until the May long weekend. It is a perfect time to reach out to your child's teacher for an update. Especially if your child had some first term challenges. Reading with your child every day and quick and fun math challenges for 5-10 mins a day is a great way to support your child's learning. Math challenges in primary; one more two more, one less two less. So what's one more than 67? Two more, one less. etc. As they get good with the metal math, ask 5 more, 10 more. It's a great way to get kids thinking without to much prep work. I ask these questions during car rides, at dinner, or as part of our homework routine. Reading in Junior; Asking questions about what they think will happen? Or having them summarize what they read to you in their own words is great practice. These are just a couple quick things to do, ask your teacher for more ideas. It's not about the worksheets, it's about the thinking.

School Organization 2018-19

Class building is something we take very seriously. We use our knowledge of your child as a learner to make choices that will serve their academic interests. We also take into account historic information. While we strive to ensure that kids have a social connection with peers, their academic needs take priority. We will have a number of combined classes next year. There are a number of myths related to combined classes, such as the students in the lower grades are the strong academically and the students in the higher grade are not. We will not create classes that reflect this myth. We create classes that are diverse and balanced.
