

Dear Gatestone Families,

Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board supports the <u>Ministerial Order</u> as an effort to contain the spread of COVID-19. We appreciate your patience and understanding as we engage the direction to close schools.

Public schools will remain closed to teachers until Friday, May 1, 2020, and to students until Monday, May 4, 2020. As these dates come closer, this decision will be re-evaluated by the Ministry of Education based on public health advice. The closure may be extended if necessary to protect the health and safety of students, families and staff. A friendly reminder to families and students that Gatestone school property is also closed to the public during this time. This means that play structures, the school field, black top area, walkways and the school parking lot will remain closed until at least May 4, 2020.

While our Gatestone staff members reached out to parents, guardians and students this week, it was comforting to hear that many of our families in the Gatestone community are doing well during these uncertain and challenging times. Our Board will continue to update families as needed.

Gatestone staff sends best wishes for our families and their loved ones to be healthy and safe. We understand that time away from one another is difficult as we continue to practice physical distancing from one another.

This week Gatestone educators have been working hard and creatively at home to provide ways for your child to stay connected with our Gatestone learning community. We have connected with families and students in regards to technology needs and we will explore and implement new ways to instruct curriculum through virtual tools over the next month. We ask for your patience, as educators and students work through this new reality. Staff HWDSB e-mails have been posted on our Gatestone school website under the "Gatesone Staff page" should you need to connect with your child's teacher during the regular school day hours (9AM-3:20PM).

HWDSB will continue to work on preparing and deploying technology for students in need.
