## **Term 2 Report Cards**

Similar to the process in February, Term 2 Report Cards will be sent to parents via SchoolMessenger. You will receive the following message below. You do not need to contact the school for passwords as it is your child's birth date. Please make sure to include the slashes.

Sample Message:

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Hamilton Wentworth District School Board has prepared a secure document for you. Due to Covid-19 you will be receiving an unsigned, electronic copy of the report card. A signed, official copy will be placed in the student's OSR which is kept at the school.

This email contains a secure link to your student's report card. When you click the link, you will be prompted to enter in a password. The password will be your student's date of birth, and it must be entered using the format MM/DD/YYYY (including forward slashes /). Please note that the link will expire after 7 days and will no longer be accessible after this point. Once the link is opened you have the option to download a PDF copy and save it for your records.

Report Cards will be sent home starting June 24<sup>th</sup>. Please keep in mind the process may take a few days. Students with an Individual Education Plan will receive their IEP through encrypted e-mail from our school resource support. Please feel free to reach out to our main office should you have further questions.

Families had the opportunity in May to share any information regarding a specific learning environment for September 2021. Class placements are complete and will be shared on the Term 2 Report Card.
