

Land Acknowledgement

What is Parent Council?

Every school must have a school council and members include parents, the principal, a teacher, a nonteaching staff member and a community representative. The majority of members must be parents

THE ROLE OF THE SCHOOL COUNCIL IS TO:

- Advise the principal and, where appropriate, the school board.
- Place students' interest first
- Support school planning goals
- Encourage parent and community involvement
- Promote positive attitudes towards public education
- School Councils provide input to the principal or the board on any matter. The Principal is ultimately responsible for activities related to the school and therefore is responsible for school council activities.
- Principals do not vote on school council decisions

"through the active participation of parents, to improve pupil achievement and to enhance the accountability of the education system to parents."

Purpose of Parent Council - Education Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. E.2

What is Parent Council to me?

- To me, Parent Council is where I get to hear about what is going at school, how the school is focusing on areas for improvement
- It gives us a place to discuss how current events may be changing or shaping events at the school

Parent Council Positions

We can't do all these wonderful things without you, the Gatestone Parents Involvement! For a successful Parent Council we need to have parents volunteer some of their time in The following positions:

- Chair / Co-chair
 - Create agenda for council meetings working with Principal, and facilitate meetings
- Secretary
 - Record meeting minutes and forward to council after meetings
- Treasurer
 - Work with Gatestone staff to ensure accurate record of council's financials
- Fundraising Chair
 - Facilitate fundraising activities at Gatestone with the support of other council members
- Voting Member
 - Plan to be present at all meetings require at least 50% of voting members present to make a decision

Time Commitment



- Per our regulations councils are to meet at least 4 times per year. Additional meetings can be held for planning of events
- Meetings will be held via Teams and when we can have a meeting TOGETHER, we will still have the Teams option for you to join!
- We're a casual bunch and keep it pretty simple, open to feedback and suggestions!

My Experience

As Chair I have spent about an hour outside of meetings putting together the agenda, then the main objective for me is to ensure everyone is heard during our meetings, and to try to keep us to our timeframe.

If all items aren't addressed - we can address them via email, or arrange for a follow up with the right parties to be involved

- Treasurer Update
- Community Representative Update
- Old Business review any outstanding items from previous meeting
- New Business/Round Table ask any questions
- Review next meeting date and any action items
- Sometimes we have guest speakers too!
