Dear Gatestone families,

Gatestone staff is excited to welcome back students once again, in person and remotely. The pandemic continues to affect many of our school operations and our Gatestone families. We will continue to work together to keep our students and families safe! Below are some important reminders and some changes to our protocols. Please also review the Gatestone Site Plan in the Community Updates for further details regarding our school routines and adherence to public health measures.

We appreciate that families may have a lot of questions as they prepare to send their children back to classes and are committed to sharing updates as we receive new information. We also invite families to keep up with communications from HWDSB by subscribing to email updates or following @hwdsb on social media.

A friendly reminder that the first day of school will be **Wednesday, September 8 for Grades, 1-8 and Thursday, September 9 for all Grades, Kindergarten - 8**. We understand that this falls on the last day of Rosh Hashanah, and will be working directly with families who require accommodation for this day. Please reach out to the school if you have any questions.

We know that safety is on the minds of every family sending their child/ren back to school. We are taking many actions to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in our classes while giving our students meaningful experiences which focus on both their physical and emotional well-being. Here are some important points for families to remember as students prepare for the start of the school year.

#### **Attestation**

Before a student can enter a school, we require that their family completes an attestation form in the parent portal for the first day of school, September 8<sup>th</sup>. Students must have this attestation form completed to attend school. You can locate the attestation form on the Parent Portal. (Backup location for forms and translations.)

## **Daily COVID-19 Screening**

HWDSB COVID-19 Student Screening Checklist is to be completed daily before arriving at school. This year students will need to present proof of completed screening daily. More information will be shared with families soon regarding this process. If your child does not pass the daily screener, the family should contact Public Health (905) 974-9848 or their family doctor for testing. Please contact the school using <a href="SafeArrival">SafeArrival</a> to report the absence. If the student is tested for COVID-19, your school would appreciate knowing the outcome of that test.

### **Visiting Schools**

This year, our school must significantly continue to limit or even prohibit visitors to school, including parents, to support a safe and healthy learning environment. We ask families to call or email our school if they need to supply information or contact a staff member. Parents are asked to not drop off items during the school day to avoid unnecessary traffic and exposure on school grounds. Please contact the school first if you believe you need to bring an item to the school. We may be able to problem solve

to avoid the extra traffic on the school grounds. Students should come prepared for learning daily with a lunch, water bottle, appropriate clothing and learning materials.

#### **Junior Kindergarten Orientation**

Our Kindergarten staff has e-mailed or phoned our families of JK students or those students new to SK to set up a classroom visit on Wednesday, September 8. We ask one parent only attend. A medical screening will be completed prior to entering the building. Parents must sign in at our main office prior to visiting the classroom and must wear our Board PPE (medical mask provided at the office).

#### **Technology**

Students returning to in-class learning that borrowed a school ipad last school year and have not yet returned the device, should bring the device back on the first day with student name and current grade labelled. We appreciate families support in returning these devices in a timely manner so we can redistribute for in-person learning.

#### **School Council**

Our 1<sup>st</sup> School Council Information session will take place on MS Teams in the evening of September 15. All families are welcome. We encourage our families you to attend this meeting to find out more about our school council and different ways our family community can help. Nominations forms for council will be sent home in early September and there will be another council meeting the evening of September 29<sup>th</sup> on MS Teams to determine council positions and voting members. #### Busing

Year 1 or Year 2 Kindergarten students that are assigned to a bus should be riding the bus to and from school. If your child is participating in morning or after school care with Umbrella Day Care, please notify transportation immediately of the times your child will be attending Umbrella. Transportation will then notify the school of the updated busing information for your child. Parents/guardians are still advised to also notify your child's homeroom teacher and main office of any changes to busing transportation. This

provides the school with an accurate list of when your child should be riding the bus to and from school.

Busing is only provided for our Year 1 and Year 2 Kindergarten students and a small group of students that live outside of the required walking kilometres to Gatestone.

## **Class Assignments for September 2021**

Families had the opportunity in May of 2021 to share any information regarding a specific learning environment for September 2021. Class placements are complete. **Due to class size caps and adhering to Public Health Measures, we are not able to make changes to class placements.** Our staff is always prepared to support learners that may feel anxious or worried about moving to a new grade, class or working with new peers or teachers. As a school community we recognize transitions can be challenging for some of our students. Staff are trained to support in these transitions and ready to help problem solve and guide when necessary. Please do not request changes to the office for class placements for September 2021 as we are not able to honour changes at this time for the start up. HWDSB will monitor our school enrolment numbers in September and determine whether a reorganization at the end of September is necessary. All schools follow the same process yearly.

#### **Remote Learning Transitions**

HWDSB is providing an opportunity for elementary students to transition between inperson and <u>Remote Learning</u> later this fall.

Starting Friday, September 3, families who want a change for their child/ren between learning models can make their choice in the Parent Portal. The survey will close one week later, Friday, September 10, and students will make their transition between learning models in early October.

Families requesting a transition between remote and in-person learning this September are reminded that students will begin the school year in their original selection and will not complete their transition until a later date. Students who did not previously select the Remote Learning option in the June 2021 survey are considered in-person learners by default.
