Rapid Antigen Tests

The week of December 13 the school staff will distribute one package of five rapid antigen tests to your child to take home. There is an important letter that will come home with the kits. Please read the letter to fully understand the when to use the rapid antigen screening kit.

Your child's participation in this rapid antigen testing is **voluntary**.

A staff member marked that a child had received the testing kits. If your child will be absent on the delivery date, they can pick their kit up the following day.

Students are not required to participate in order to return to the classroom after the winter break.

Together, with Hamilton Public Health Services, we are supporting additional action to prevent the spread of Covid-19, giving parents another tool to access volunteer testing, and further protect in-person learning.

Census Survey

At Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board (HWDSB), we are committed to identifying and removing barriers so we can offer all students supportive, inclusive, and respectful learning environments.

To learn more about our students, we conducted a confidential census in April 2021. *We All Count: HWDSB Student Census 2021* gathered identity-based student data so that we can identify and address systemic barriers by focusing our programming and resources. **The student census has been reintroduced in 2021-22**, **due to the challenges of conducting it during the remote learning period**. **The survey opened Monday, November 29th in the Parent Portal for students in Kindergarten to Grade 4. Previous Updates

Dress for Weather

With the damp weather in December, our field area becomes quite wet with several muddy patches. We want to have students outside on our field area as much as possible to allow for appropriate distancing without masks outside. Please pack extra outdoor shoes or rain boots for your child to enjoy the field. Days when we are unable to access the field and need to implement a Blacktop only recess, students will follow an outdoor rotating schedule with their class to ensure appropriate physical distancing and removal of masks can occur. Both nutrition breaks still occur regardless and every class will have one outdoor scheduled time during one of the nutrition breaks. Educators will also plan for another time in their day where students can move around outside on our blacktop areas to receive some fresh air and more outdoor exercise.

Lately, we have endured more blacktop and indoor recesses than usual due to damp weather conditions. Our school will be implementing, Walking Wednesdays, as another opportunity to get outside for more exercise. During the morning, classes will have an assigned time to walk outside around our school pathways and blacktop area. Daily Physical Activity (20minutes) will continue to occur on days students do not have Physical Education as well.
