Staffing Updates – Educational Assistant added to our school, half time reading specialist, math facilitator coming soon, hiring for a music teacher

Terry Fox Run – approximately \$5,700 raised

Nya-weh Program – lacross learning opportunities

Heritage Green Grant – Kristie Luker – \$42,000 grant proposal for a pop up 'maker-space' for coding, computers, cricut, microbits, tech, laptop kit, etc. This would set up to allow teachers to sign out the supplies and go from class to class, and support community engagement events. The school has not heard back if it has been approved or not. School Council agreed last year to support some of the ongoing supplies and supporting events in the community.

Extra Curricular Activities – Staff who support these activities are volunteering and not all extra curricular activities will have a staff member who signs up. The school may also require additional volunteers to support the activities.

Police Clearances for Volunteers – all school volunteers require a vulnerable sector police clearance and to meet with the school Principal or Vice Principal to discuss volunteering and be approved and be on file.

Crossing Guard – Diane has not heard back from the City in relations to an evaluations for Shadyglenn and Gatestone area. Diane will connect back with the City in relations to this.

Concerns related to the individual child can be brought to the school teacher or Principal/Vice Principal to discuss privately as it relates to your own child. There is an opportunity

Gatestone & Shannen Koostachin Boundary Review – proposed boundary change in a portion of Shannen Koostachin (approx. 150 students). Current enrollment Shannen Koostachin 637, Gatestone 510. Shannen Koostachin is currently at 140% utilization of school. Gatestone is currently at 88% utilization of school. Public Consultation will be held in future in December 2023. The change is proposed for implementation for September 2024. Two Council members are apart of the committee to attend the future meetings to represent the school.
