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WE Scare Hunger

Hunger + Food Drive = IMPACT

Hunger affects people from all walks of life, including those we might not suspect. People who experience food insecurity are often forced to make difficult choices. Parents choose between skipping meals and feeding their children. Do they buy groceries or pay the rent or electricity bill? When we come together to collect food for people struggling with hunger, we can help ensure they have resources to feed themselves and their families.

From October 15th to 31st, the Glen Brae staff and students have been participating in our annual food drive. This year, the school goal was to collect 1500 items. The Glen Brae Community came together and exceeded that goal, collecting 1840 items and \$1542.05

The food collected will be picked up by Eastgate FORD and delivered to Mission Services of Hamilton. Mission Services is a local community organization that supports many families in the city of Hamilton. More than a meal, Mission Services is an agency who believes every person deserves safe housing, healthy food and opportunities for tomorrow.

The Social Justice Club voted to split the money collected, sending 50% to support our WE community in Ecuador and 50% to Mission Services for the purchase of fresh food items.

Thank you to all of the parents, guardians and other family members who so generously opened their cupboards and wallets to support this very worthy cause.

The Social Justice Club will begin selling Rafiki bracelets on November 12. All bracelets are \$10.00 each, with the exception of the new Lily Singh Girl Love 3.0, which is \$18 and includes 2 bracelets for the intention of sharing.

For Kenyan artisans, women's empowerment means taking charge of their future. Using traditional art forms, each handcrafted Rafiki bracelet empowers female artisans by enabling them to earn a fair wage for their work. For every item you sell, half of the proceeds will go to your school's chosen WE Villages country and pillar of choice! By fundraising with WE Are Rafikis, you are helping women in developing communities earn money to invest in their futures.

Not only do these bracelets help to support Kenyan women, but 50% of the proceeds will go to support our WE Community in Ecuador. They also make really great Christmas gifts. With many designs to choose from, students can purchase bracelets in November for delivery before Christmas.

School Cash on Line

- 1. Register
 - a) If you have not registered, please go to the School Cash Online home page https://hwdsb.schoolcashonine.com and select the "Get Started today" option.
 - b) Complete each of the three registration steps
- 2. Confirmation Email
 - a) A registration confirmation email will be forwarded to you. Click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and School Cash Online account.
 - b) The confirmation link will open the School Cash Online site prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password just created with your account.
- 3. Find Student This step will connect your children to your account
 - a) Verify the School Board Name
 - b) Select the School Name
 - c) Enter your child's first name, last name and date of birth

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d) Select "Continue"

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- e) On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in the Agree box and select "Continue"
- f) Your child has been added to your account.
- 4. View items or Add another student
 - a) If you have more children, select "Add another Student" and repeat the steps above.
