#### Cell Phones

Some of the things that students can enjoy include milk, cheese, yogurt, bagels, omelets, hard boiled eggs, muffins, crackers, fruit, veggies and cereal.

We know that nutrition is a fundamental determinant of healthy child development & that good nutrition enhances a child's ability to learn. All students who attend Glen Brae have access to the morning snack.

The nutrition program is only possible due to a group of committed student volunteers who arrive early each day to prepare the carts and our wonderful Educational Assistants who truly make the program possible.
