## Information Regarding Grade 9 Health and Physical Education

At this time Ms. Jeffrey and Mr. Morgan would like to welcome you to Glendale and provide a little information which might be of some use for your son/daughter as they enter high school. Health and physical education at the secondary level is a mandatory credit for all Grade Nine students and, as such, students must participate on a daily basis during the course. We ask that students come to class prepared for physical activity, and for the weather, as we will be outside at various times, even when the weather is less than ideal. Students must wear shorts or track pants and a T-shirt or sweatshirt as well as running shoes for class. We will be offering GLENDALE PHYS. ED. T-shirts this year at a very reasonable cost of \$10.00 each. The shirts come in white, black and grey. This is not mandatory, but we would encourage you to purchase at least one, as we very often see students who do not want to ruin their more expensive brand name shirts. It also helps if you have two, as you can wash one and have the other available for use. We recommend that personal valuables be kept at home. No valuables should be left in the gym locker rooms during class.
