School Parking Lot	Self-driving students may use the school parking-lot. To minimize vehicle traffic and maximize student and staff safety, student drop-offs will not be permitted at the back parking lot.
Entry and Exit Doors for Students	On the first day of school, students will be allowed entrance to the school via one of three (3) access points : 1) Front Entrance 2) Gym Entrance (back parking lot) 3) Cafeteria Entrance (back parking lot) After the first day of school, students will enter and exit the school via the access doors closest to their assigned classroom.
Parent Access to School	In order to maximize student, staff, and community safety, access to the school will be very limited for parents, volunteers and visitors. Please contact the main office before coming to the school to speak with a staff member.

Ill or Injured Students	Ill or injured students will wait in a separate supervised location within the school. The school office will contact parents immediately to come to the school for pick up.
