

## GLENDALE SECONDARY GRADUATION DAY

JUNE 23, 2021 (RAIN DATE – JUNE 24)



### Q. How do I book a time for my June 23 Drive/Walk Through Grad?

A. At 9 am on Wednesday, June 16th our online booking system will open. You will need your 5 or 6-digit student number found on any report card you may have.

#### Instructions

1. Go to the scheduling webpage at <https://glendale-grad.parentinterview.com/>
2. Enter your 5 or 6-digit HWDSB student number and click "Sign In". If you can't find this number, contact us and we'll help.
3. Fill in your contact information and click "Continue to Make Appointments"
4. Click on "Graduation Appointments"
5. Click on "Available" for a time at which you wish to arrive.
6. Click on "My Schedule" (top left of the page)
7. Print out, email or copy down your appointment time

### Q. Where should I go on Grad Day, June 23<sup>rd</sup>?

A. Your Grad Day experience **starts** at the intersection of Glen Echo and Rainbow Drive, and **ends** at the front entrance to the school (see map below). Arrive at the time slot you booked. If coming in a vehicle, enter via Nash Road onto Rainbow Drive, then follow Rainbow Drive towards the front of school. We have several things for you including your grad gown and cap which you might want to put on right away. You may also drop off any outstanding school resources such as library books, iPad, sports jerseys, or textbooks. If you're walking, cycling, longboarding, or coming via HSR, please line up on the sidewalk along Rainbow Drive.

Then you'll keep on going towards the front entrance where, if you want, you can have your photo professionally taken, as well as for families to take their own photos. Finally, you'll proceed, one-way, along Rainbow Drive towards Secord Drive and be on your way to whatever festivities you've got planned.



**Q. I've heard that some parents and grads are not getting email updates about Grad week. What can we do about that?**

A. We very much want to reach EVERY grad. So, please help us find those people if you know that they've been missed. Since some grads are already 18, our system automatically stops sending parent emails home until the student officially gives consent that parent contact is OK. This explains why some parents have not received generic information about grad week. We are happy to send emails if they tell us who they are. So, please let others know that we are trying to reach them. Some emails we have on file are now old or incorrect. We have messaged to all Gr 12s and their families, but still some emails are bouncing back and we don't know to whom they belong. So, yes please, as you're able, spread the word that we are trying to find everyone.

**Q. I'm worried about Covid. Will it be safe for me to come to Grad Day?**

A. Our Grad Day plan has been vetted through HWDSB in consultation with Public Health. Therefore, if you follow the rules of social distancing and follow the directions, you'll be fine. If you want your photo taken at our photo station, it will be you and only your immediate family members (those who came with you) in

the picture. Unfortunately, we cannot support group shots with those outside your family at this time due to public health guidelines.

### **Q. Who is allowed to come with me to Grad Day?**

A. Come with all the people who care about you, but only with those who can safely fit in your vehicle. If you are walking up, please limit your guests to yourself and two others. Please ask them to stay together in the vehicle or, if walking-up, to stay socially distanced from other guests. Please also tell them that there will be no school access on that day. So, bring your own water and snacks, if you wish, and visit the restroom ahead of time.

### **Q. What's the dress code for Grad Day?**

A. Please wear whatever helps you most remember Glendale Secondary. Some of you will want to wear t-shirts and sweat pants in honour of the Covid survival you've just come through. Others may want to wear their prom dresses and tuxedos. Others like orange and black, or perhaps sports jerseys to help you remember a team you were on. The important thing is that you show up and celebrate who you are and that you're a grad. As students told us, "It's all about the picture." What do you want in the picture? Oh yes, some of you will get dressed in your finest only because you really want 'the picture.' However, there is no need to go out and get a new gown or suit. Whatever you wear can be capped off with your grad gown and cap which we will provide. If you want to decorate your vehicle, or your longboard, or your bicycle, please go ahead and do that, too.

### **Q. Will I get my real diploma on June 23rd?**

A. No. And here's the reason why. The diplomas are printed on very special paper which we order from the Ministry of Education. They send us only the exact number of pages we need, one for each grad. It's almost as secure as getting a passport printed. However, due to Covid and school closures, the Ministry is not shipping these special papers until some time in the future. So, you will eventually get your real diplomas but as of today we don't have an exact date. In the meantime, if you require a transcript, we can help via formal requests that you can make through the office.

### **Q. I think I might be getting an award. How will I receive it?**

A. Normally we hand out awards at the formal Grad Ceremony. This year, however, some of the awards are being sent out from HWDSB via Canada Post, especially if it is a monetary award. We felt that students would want that money now rather than later in the Fall. Glendale-specific awards will be announced in due time after consultation with our Awards Committee.
