



Transportation

Transportation is offered to all program students **who live 3.2** kms away from the school. This is guaranteed! The type of transportation given is at the discretion of Hamilton Wentworth Student Transportation Services. A Hamilton Street Railway student bus pass is the most common form, but some program students qualify for a school bus or cab. **Glendale has no input into the type of transportation offered**. Students who qualify for transportation will be contacted by HWSTS the last week of August or first week of September. Glendale asks that you have alternative transportation available for the first week – just in case.

Purpose

Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board (HWDSB) believes in supporting student success and well-being. The HWDSB Audition-Based Program of the Arts (ABPA) aligns student passions with programming, educating and training students in all aspects of the arts.

The 'Program Success Review' is a process for ABPA staff to support students: areas of need are identified and a plan to support student success and well-being is put in place. Ultimately, this plan may involve changes to programming at Glendale, or a return to the student's catchment school.

Qualifying Conditions

Qualifying Conditions for Program Success Review


- Student is achieving less than 75% in an ABPA core courses (A or G), AND/OR
- Student is achieving less than 60% in any other course AND/OR
- Student has demonstrated behaviours that are harmful to self or others, or that hinder the ABPA Program







Filmmaking & Photo Portfolio: should contain mostly photos and/or videos and may also contain upto TWO traditional artworks.

Media Arts Portfolio: may contain any digital medium (character designs, game art, graphic design, animation, digital painting, sound, animation, etc.)

Written artistic challenge to showcase ability to solve problems and think creatively. Includes lighting and music/sfx choices.



Taking a good photo



PHOTOGRAPHING ARTWORK:

- Bring your artwork outside or near a door/window to avoid shadows and colour distortion.
- Hold phone or laptop directly level with work and use camera grid to avoid warping
- Get rid of background distractions and crop your image – fill the frame
- Tap to focus

Performing Arts Applicants Should do the Following:

- Dress appropriately black or plain clothing that is comfortable, hair pulled back and off face
 - Dancers need to have full movement in their outfit and have dance shoes or running shoes
- Arrive early to stretch, tune, warm up in the cafeteria
- Have their materials ready to go
 - Copies of sheet music for panel, copy of backing tracks (mp3, mp4) on a flash drive, patch chords/picks, monologue memorized, dance personalized section ready to go


