We have just finished our third week of remote learning. Everyone needs good health and wellness. This week, there were daily announcements about breathing, physical movement, visualization, and distraction strategies to be used to cope with stress and feel calm. We want to support our students.

Attendance: Now, we are learning online. Attendance is taken twice daily: teachers will take attendance during their Teams meeting between 9:00 -9:50 am everyday and then again after 1:30 pm nutrition break. If your child's absence is unexplained, you will receive a phone call from the School Messenger system. If your child is absent, you can enter their absence using the School Messenger system.

<u>Student Census</u>: As part of HWDSB Equity Action Plan, HWDSB will conduct our first student census, beginning May 3^{rd} . "We All Count" aims to identify and remove barriers so all student can learn in supportive, inclusive and respectful environments. The survey will be completed between May 3 - 21, 2021.

Students in Kindergarten to Grade 4: Families will receive an email with a secure link to the census form. This will allow families to complete the census online on behalf of their child. Print copies are available by request to <u>census@hwdsb.on.ca</u>. If you have questions, please contact the school. To opt out, families can just simply ignore the email and not complete the survey.

Students in Grade 5-12: HWDSB will email a secure link to students so they can complete the census online during class time, with educator support. Families who do not want their Grade 5-8 child to participate to complete the opt out form in the Parent Portal or to email <u>census@hwdsb.on.ca</u> by April 30th. Students who opt out by this deadline will not receive the student census email May 3. Students who haven't formally opted out can ignore the census email or us the active consent in the census itself where they can agree or not agree to complete the census form.
