**PINK SHIRT DAY:** GREENSVILLE STAFF AND STUDENTS



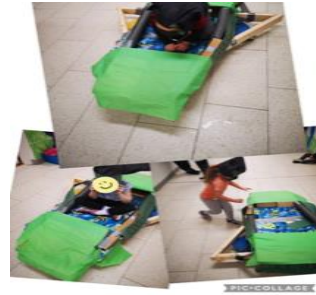
