- Educational Assistant, Mr. Liberty is covering Mrs. Kott's absence. We anticipate her return in June. As well, Ms. Jino is in an LTO role until a permanent EA is hired for September.
- Mrs. Sleep is back in her 0.5 teaching role: Remote Grade 5 + Prep Coverage.
