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the school, without notice, isn't very efficient and often creates more work for the office. If we know in advance, we can prepare students and staff and update our records accordingly. As well, some students are still texting home **before** informing the office (i.e., not feeling well). Students are not to be using their phones for this reason, unless they have permission from the office. It is for safety reasons that we ask students to visit the office first prior to reaching out to parents. Please help us with this matter – it will make a big impact on how efficiently the office runs.

<u>Lunch Hour Calls:</u> Please note, when Mrs. Taugher is on her lunch, I watch the office on my own during that time. As a result, I am not able to answer the phone as I'm usually tending to another school issue. Sometimes I'm called away from the office which means I may not be able to answer the door, either. That is another reason for logging an early dismissal so we can plan ahead and have students ready and waiting. If you leave a message during this time, it won't be received until Mrs. Taugher returns from her lunch. Currently, I am watching the office from 12:30 – 1:30 pm, daily. However, that time may change next month. I will keep you posted.

Lost & Found: Already, we have a pile of clothes left behind at school. Most of these items get forgotten outside during break time. Despite countless reminders, students fail to bring in their sweaters and jackets. Please encourage your child to take responsibility for their personal items and bring them back home with them each night. Once our bin is full, we lay out items for students/families to recoup. Afterwards, all leftovers are dropped off at a local charity. We simply do not have the space to keep the items that accumulate over the course of the year.

<u>Parking:</u> Thank you for doing your part to keep our students, staff and visitors safe while on school property. Please stay with your vehicle if you are not parked in a valid spot. Drivers should not be leaving their vehicle unattended and idling. We've had some close calls over the years and all of those incidents were easily preventable. A bylaw ticket is \$275.
