

Instructions for Finding Student Number in Career Cruising

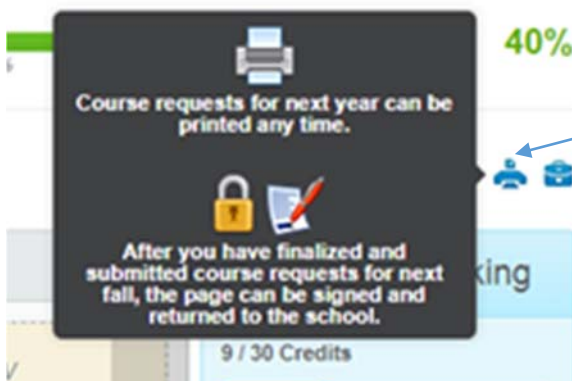
- Students will log into the HUB and enter their Nora Henderson Guidance Course. Choose the Career Cruising symbol within the My Tools area, then select Choose My Courses or Course Planner



- Once in the Course Planner you will be able to view the following...
