Application must be attached. **Academic Courses (D)** can lead to apprenticeship, college, university or workplace destinations. **Applied Courses (P)** can lead to apprenticeship, college or workplace destinations. University *may* be an option. **Open Courses (O)** can lead to apprenticeship, college, university or workplace destinations.

Locally Developed Courses (L) can lead to apprenticeship or workplace destinations. College *may* be an option. **eLearning (eL)** are courses offered online and meet the same curriculum expectations as day classes.
