Land Acknowledgement



De-streaming Grade 9 in HWDSB




In grade 9, all students will take a common Grade 9 Program (English, French, Geography, Math and Science) and will choose their 3 elective courses.

- Students earns STEM certificate and engage in pathway planning for post-secondary programs in STEM fields.


