## PICK-UP & DROP-OFF PROTOCOLS

Strict public health protocols will be followed during the pandemic. This will include limiting access for parents/ caregivers to the playground.

Morning Routines (8:50 am)

- Kindergarten Parents/caregivers should bring their kindergarten aged student to the gate to the kindergarten play area on Hess St. at the back of the school. Staff will receive your child and supervise their play in the kindergarten play area
- Grades 1 to 8 Parents/caregivers are asked to say good-bye to their children at the Queen St. or Hess St. entrances to the playground. Students will go directly to their class' assigned space on the play-ground and line up

#### Afternoon Routines (3:10 pm)

- Kindergarten parents/caregivers are asked to return to the gate to the kindergarten play area and wait for the kindergarten staff to "hand off" their child directly to their care
- Grades 1 to 8 Parents/caregivers are to wait on the playground in the area assigned to their child's class, teachers will bring their class to this area at dismissal. If you are picking up more than one student, go to the youngest child's assigned area first. Older students may walk home without a parent escort.

## RETURNING TO IN-SCHOOL LEARNING

Parents have the opportunity to have their children return from the Remote school to learning at Hess Street School. We know that before school started up, many parents were worried that in school learning might not be safe for their children.

Since reopening there have been no (zero) COVID-19 cases at Hess Street School. We have protocols in place when a student or staff member develop COVID-like symptoms. Students are isolated until their parent can pick them up, their teacher takes the class to the library while their entire classroom is sanitized. Only when it is safe to do so does the teacher bring their class back. All students who have had COVID-like symptoms have tested negative.

While remote learning helps students to not fall behind, it is not a real substitute for in-person learning where a teacher can better meet a child's needs.

We look forward to welcoming your child back to Hess Street and ask that you seriously consider having them return on November 3. You can request a change from remote to in-school learning through the Parent Portal. Requests must be made no later than Tuesday, October 13, 2020.

#### Parents/guardians are reminded to:

- Complete the self screening checklist every morning (go to: https://www.hwdsb.on.ca/about/covid19/studentscreening-translated-documents/) with their child.
- Inform the school if their child has "failed" the screening and contact public health to book a COVID test (call 905-974-9848 or book online at www.HamiltonCovidTest.ca)
- Pick up their child immediately from school if they develop potential COVID symptoms during the day.
- Talk to your child about the importance of following the public health protocols at school.
