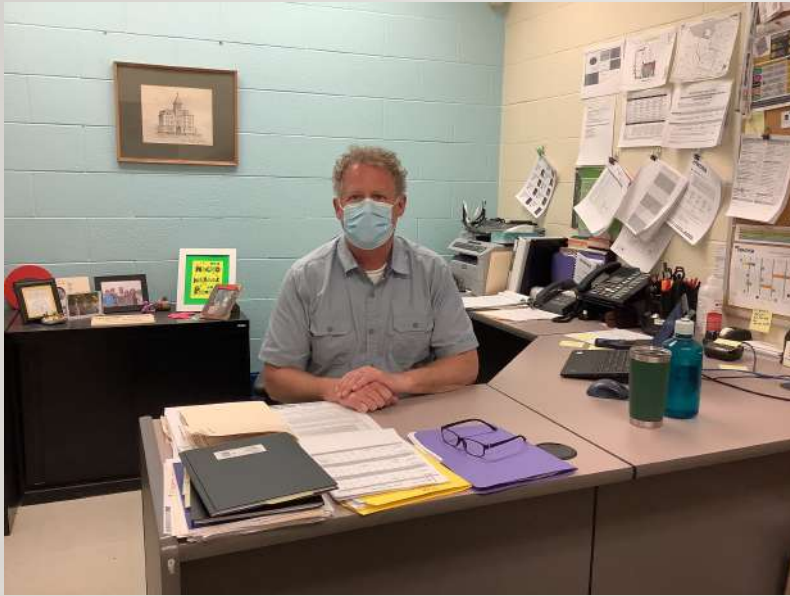

Use this booklet as your guide. It helps to explain program structures, developmental milestones, school pandemic precautions, etc.

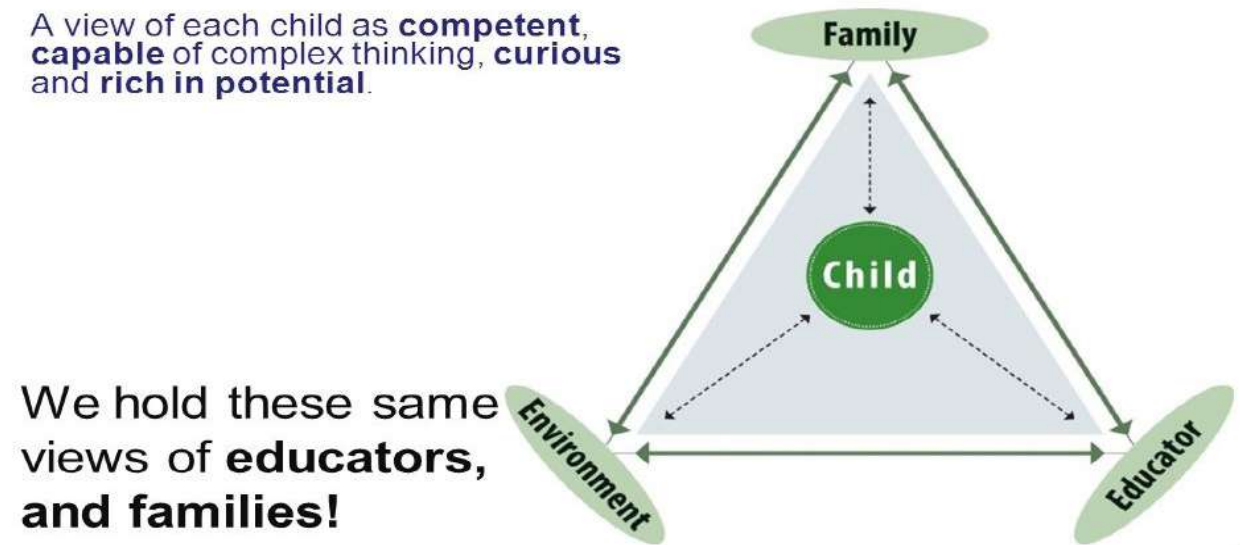
In this unique year, we will mail each family registering a child for kindergarten a copy of the updated Countdown to Kindergarten parent handbook.

Be positive – listen to your child 

Talk, read and sing to your child daily in any language!

Encourage clear speech

Encourage safe exploration and play

Promote sharing, co-operation and responsibility



Introduce your child to letters and numbers



Visit the Central library to borrow books



Complete the LOOK / SEE checklist



Practice skills for independence



Expose your child to painting, colouring and scissors



3, 2, 1... COUNTDOWN TO OUR FIRST DAY

- ❖ Visit your family doctor for immunizations and call school the office if there are medical issues we need to know about (e.g. allergies)
- ❖ Get a vision test – free eyeglasses in JK year: hwdsb.info/2PRmreS
- ❖ Address speech concerns – Early Words: hwdsb.info/2Rszrlo

(Referrals only possible up to August 31 of a child's first year in kindergarten).
