Please be reminded that those students who are eligible for bussing for the school year will receive a letter from Hamilton-Wentworth Student Transportation Services (HWSTS) indicating so over the summer. Safe Welcome Protocol:

As you know, the HWDSB has initiated a Safe Welcome Program. The program supports a welcoming learning environment by ensuring that parents and other authorized visitors can access elementary schools while keeping students and staff safe. Please be reminded that the front entrance is equipped with a video/intercom access system which is to be used to gain access. Once granted entry, all visitors must report directly to the office.
