Proceedings

Call to Order/Welcome and Introductions:

The March meeting was called to order at 6:19 p.m., with Treasurer Jenny Bognar presiding. Introductions omitted.

Acceptance of Minutes:

Ms. Askew made a motion at 6:20 p.m. to accept the previous meeting's minutes, motion was seconded by Ms. Bognar, all in favour, minutes accepted.

Ms. Wong requested to resign as Secretary, no others accepted the position, so Ms. Wong remain Secretary (Ms. Mills offered to type minutes, but not record).

Principal's Report/Teacher's Report:

Still looking for more members for school swim team.

Ms. Depew asked staff about pinnies, staff in favour of 30 more pinnies in various sizes, with numbers on back, school crest on front. Quote: \$745.80.

At 6:25, Ms. Askew made a motion to purchase 30 pinnies, motion was seconded by Ms. O'Donnell, all in favour, motion passed.

Mr. Pellizzari announced to Council that yearbook sales are ongoing at a cost of \$15.00 each. Yearbooks include every grade and all class photos.

World Down Syndrome Day – acknowledging our student with Down Syndrome, bringing awareness, and collecting donations for the Down Syndrome Association of Hamilton (which supports both children and adults with Down Syndrome).

Safe Arrival Training – Office administrators to go. There will be a new app available for devices, or directly on the website, to report student absences. Calling the school will no longer be necessary as it will instead go straight into the system, with a PIN for each student. This will be a more streamlined process and, if a student is unaccounted for, a call will go home earlier. Program has been well received in other schools. Mr. McLean's children have it at their school and it works well.

After School Scholars for grade 3s and 6s running until EQAO.

Break-in Update: Two new steel doors have been installed upstairs. Most technology has been rolled out. Two projectors replaced, new speakers installed in the rooms. Mr. McLean now has a full inventory of all technology with all serial numbers. All leased equipment has been replaced, as well as school purchased equipment. School has received about half the money back as well.

Classroom furniture needs are being addressed. Already replaced some portable carpets.

<u>Treasurer's Report (Ms. Bognar)</u>:

Ms. Zimmer was not able to present the Riccos totals yet, due to a late order being added.

Currently \$10,180.00 available. Ms. Bognar asked Council if they would like to buy more iPads. Mr. Pellizzari said that Language and Reading Resources are needed and Mr. Merifield suggested subscriptions, as discussed previously by Council.

Ms. Toskas asked if money was still going to the grade 8s. Ms. Wong said that 10% of food sales are going to the graduates.

Ms. Bognar asked if Council would like to support literacy this time.

Mr. McLean discussed playground painting (hopscotch, four square, etc.), which would cost approximately \$3,000.00 to \$4,000.00. After measuring, crew would be in and out in a day.

Mr. Pellizzari said to keep an eye on getting a second bike rack. We received the grant approval, but have yet to receive the money. Ms. Bognar suggested that Ms. Zimmer follow up.

Ms. Askew made a motion at 6:42 p.m. to set aside \$3,000.00 for Literacy, Ms. Bognar seconded the motion. All in favour, motion passed.

Math Night (Ms. Bognar):

Ms. Bognar said that to date, 76 kids and 70 adults have signed up for the April 10th STEM event. Notices will stop when we hit maximum allowed. It would cost an extra \$400.00 for another 50 students to attend. Mr. Pellizzari said that the school could cover the extra charges if necessary.

Ms. Bognar will have a sign in the night of the event.

New Business:

Council acknowledged Mr. Merifield's 40th birthday with a round of applause.

All Pizza Bags have now arrived.

Ms. Murphy asked about the dental screening and how it works, report given.

Mr. Merifield asked if the optometrist was coming to Highview this year. Mr. Pellizzari said the optometrist offers glasses for \$20.00 or free to those in need. Only students who don't get regular eye exams qualify as this is charged to their health card and children are only allowed one per year.

Mr. Merifield then asked about licencing for a Movie Night. Mr. McLean informed Council that it costs \$400.00 for licensing any movie already on DVD and \$800.00 for licensing any movie that is between theatres and DVD, allowed two per year. Mr. McLean will forward the information to Ms. Horton and Ms. Bognar. Hoping to still plan a Movie Night for this school year.

Mr. Pellizzari told Council that Kindergarten registration is going very well. There are around 46 or 47 new registrations, which brings the combined Kindergarten total to approximately 94 students. Certainly the sooner, the better when it comes to registering.

Ms. Depew added that May 13th will be the Welcome to Kindergarten Orientation.

An order went in for new Kindergarten equipment.

Motion to Adjourn:

Ms. Askew made a motion to adjourn at 6:57, Ms. O'Donnell seconded the motion, all in favour, meeting adjourned. Next meeting will be held on Wednesday, April 17 at 6:15 p.m. Mr. Pellizzari thanked Council for always coming to the meetings and supporting the school. - Enhanced ABA (Applied Behaviour Analysis) Training Course for supporting students diagnosed with ASD ongoing (Ms. DiBartolo and Mr. Preston)
- ASIST (Applied Suicide Intervention Skills) Ms. Brunaccioni and Mr. McLean both ASIST trained.
- Monthly Spirit Days are Continuing...."Twin Day" will be April 12th
- Green Team/Recycling ongoing
