






### Getting to know your child is our priority

- Educators communicate with parents in many ways



- Provides a safe and caring environment








# Your child's day







#### Things you will need:

- Water bottle
- Lunch Kit (We have 2 nutrition breaks each day)
- Indoor Shoes (Velcro if the students have trouble with tying)
- Warm clothes for Winter (Jacket, boots, snow pants, mittens)
- Multiple masks (cloth are fine)
- \*Remember to write the student's name on their items or label them.

#### Things to Practice:

- Wearing a mask
- Washing hands and hand sanitizing
- Walking to school
- Opening lunch containers (and water bottles, juice boxes, etc.)
- Putting on coats and shoes/footwear
- Doing up zippers
