






Getting to know your child is our priority

- Educators communicate with parents in many ways



SHOULD I REFER MY CHILD?

Understanding of words, directions and questions

Does your child:
☐ Look "lost" when you give directions?☐ Have trouble following daily routines?
☐ Have troubles responding to questions?

Size of vocabulary, use of grammar and length of sentences

Does your child:

Use short, incomplete sentences and/or make gramma

☐ Use short, incomplete sentences and/or make grammatical errors? (e.g., "Me go play park.")

SHOULD I REFER MY CHILD? Continued...

☐ You have concerns about your child's communication.

Pronunciation of speech sounds

boes your crima.
☐ Have speech that is NOT understood by most people outside of the family? ☐ Make errors on one or most sounds? (e.g., b, t, m, k, g, f)
Note: Sound errors involving "I", "r" and "ch" sounds are common at this age and not a concern.
Other signs:
☐ Your child does NOT look at you when called by name
☐ Your child is very reluctant to speak
Your child does NOT seem interested in playing with other children.
☐ Your child shutters (i.e. repeat sounds or words four times or more).
☐ Your child has a hoarse voice most of the time







The COUNTDOWN to the first day of school!

Things you will need:

- Reusable/Non Spillable Water bottle
- Lunch Bag (We have 2 nutrition breaks each day)
- Backpack (Big enough to fit lunch, water bottle, library book, shoes etc.)
- Shoes (We encourage parents to send indoor and outdoor running shoes with VELCRO)
- Extra set of clothing for unforeseen incidents (Spare shirt, pants, socks and underwear. Label all these items and place in a labeled Ziploc bag).
- Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather EVERYDAY. We will be outdoors every day, even in rain (except in extreme cold or thunderstorms).
- ***Remember to label everything or write the student's name on all their personal items.







The COUNTDOWN to the first day of school!

Things to Practice:

- Opening lunch containers (and water bottles, juice boxes, food wrappers etc.)
- Putting on coats and shoes (footwear) independently.
- Doing up zippers.
- Using the washroom independently.
- Getting dressed/undressed independently if child has an accident/spills.

Reporting Absences

Highview conducts a safe arrival program. If your child is going to be absent, it is requested that you report your child's absence in one of three ways.

- Use the SafeArrival website, go.schoolmessenger.ca. The first time you use the website, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.
- 2. Using your mobile device, download and install the SchoolMessenger app from Apple App Store or Google Play. The first time you use the app, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.
- 3. Call the toll-free number 1-844-506-4350 to report an absence using the automated phone system. These options are available 24 hours/day, seven days a week. You can report a future absence any time.
