Hi Parents / Caregivers,

Hope all is well. We are excited about our Grade 8 Graduation for our in-school and remote students. There is a total of 43 in-school and remote students graduating this year. Our plan for our Grade 8 Graduation celebrations will be to have an online video ceremony on one day followed the next day by a walk-up celebration. Here are the details:

Monday June 21, 2021

- 4:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.– Online video formal graduation ceremony recognizing each student, subject specific awards and awards of merit.

Tuesday June 22, 2021

- Our walk-up celebrations will take place on the Broker St. side of the school on our grass. This will provide us with shade and ensure social distancing. There will be four stations set up with tents. Our walk up will start at the west side of the grass area (closest to the Rec Centre) moving towards the east side (towards staff parking lot). All stations will be supported by staff. Each graduating student may bring three family members (therefore a maximum of four people per family).
- You will be receiving an online google form link to choose the hour your family wants to attend the walk-up celebrations (for example, 9:00 – 10:00 a.m. or 10:00 – 11:00 a.m.). Once you choose your hour timeslot, you will receive an email indicating your appointment time within the hour you chose.
- Our four stations are:
  1. Covid Screening and iPad drop off.
  2. Diploma and graduation grass sign pickup.
  3. Photo area.
  4. Pick up of personal belongings.
- 9:00 a.m. forward our walk up begins
  - Public Health and Covid Precautions
    - Each graduating student may bring three family members (therefore a maximum of four people)
    - All people participating must attend to Covid screening and wear a mask (hand sanitizer will be made available).
    - At the completion of station 4. Pick up of personal belongings, families will be directed to leave our school property. This is to ensure gatherings do not take place.
    - Each family will move through each station together; there shall not be two or more families gathering together.
    - All photos taken with staff shall ensure social distancing of two metres.
    - There will not be any access to the school.
  - Each family will have approximately 5 minutes to move through the stations

Wednesday June 23 or Thursday June 24, 2021

- Rain dates
