## **REPORT CARDS**

The board has changed the date for report card distribution. Elementary report cards are being sent out to parents, guardians, and caregivers on Monday, June 28<sup>th</sup> and not Thursday, June 24<sup>th</sup> as previously announced. Report cards will be delivered as secure documents using PowerSchool.

When you receive the email about report cards, to see the report card you will need to enter the student's DATE OF BIRTH in numerals as Month/Day/Year. (I.e. MM/DD/YYYY)

Enter 0 before the single digit. For example, the password for a child born on September 23, 2012 is 09/23/2012. For a child born on November 5, 2009, the password is 11/05/2009 including the slash between the month and day and year.

This emailed report card is an unofficial document because it is not signed. If you need a paper copy of the report card, please contact the school in the fall. Home schools will receive a copy of all report cards for students in the remote learning program.

#### **iPad RETURN**

All students that have an iPad must return it to the school **Monday, June 28 between 9:00 and 1:00**. Please ensure that the iPads are in a labeled bag with the cord and adapter that you received. Please come to the main door where Mr. Gunell will be collecting them. It is extremely important that these are returned so that they are ready for students in September.
