Dear Parent/Caregiver:

Welcome to the 2022-2023 school year. We are looking forward to an outstanding year at Kanétskare Elementary School. Our entire staff is to be commended for all of their hard work in preparing their classrooms and the school for your children. We hope you have had a great summer with your families and friends. We look forward to helping your children be curious and creative to see all the possibilities in their learning socially, emotionally and academically. Thank you to Mr. Veldhuis, Mr. Danby and Ms. Silj for their hard work in making our halls and classrooms glisten in the midst of all the ongoing renovations. Thank you also to Ms. Murphy for her leadership and organization in the office.

We are excited to welcome students back to class – in person and remote learning – for the 2022-23 school year. We know that the past two years have been challenging, and we are thrilled to see students, staff and families again. Each new year is a great new opportunity.

A friendly reminder that the first day of school will be **Tuesday**, **September 6**, **2022**.

We know that many families remain concerned about safety, and we are too. We continue to take COVID-19 precautions, such as doing daily COVID-19 school and child care screening and staying home when sick or instructed within the screening tool.

We are pumped and ready for another year of teaching and learning with your children. School begins at 8:40 a.m. and concludes at 3:00 p.m. Please know that the playground is supervised 15 minutes before school and 15 minutes after school. We would ask that if your child is walking or being dropped off that you are aware of these times for their safety. Please avoid dropping students off at the front doors in the morning. It is important to keep the bus loading zone free from traffic. We are encouraging students to arrive before the bell and enter with their respective classes at the back playground. Additionally, it is extremely important to be at school on time as it creates a sense of calm, decreases interruptions in the class and promotes a team atmosphere as classes enter the school together.

We are aiming to reduce the number of interruptions in class learning time and therefore, we are respectfully asking parents to not request their children to be dismissed during the last 30 minutes of the day (2:30-3:00 pm).

First Day Procedures:

On the first day of school, all students will arrive at Kanétskare Elementary School and head directly to the back playground. We will have a check in station where staff will assist you to let you know the location and/or who your homeroom teacher is for the year and where to line up on the first day. Renovations:

Our school is currently being updated both internally and externally. We have new ceiling tiles and lighting in the hallways. Our gym has a new floor and has been brightened with a fresh coat of paint. The Learning Commons and an additional classroom are being updated. We will also have the Art Room (homeroom for 78A), Science Room (homeroom for 8B) and the Music room updated during the school year. Safe Welcoming Schools:


