Communication

School emails are also available in the app. You must sign in with the same email address you provided to the school when registering your student.

Please note that field trips usually cost a small to moderate amount of money. You always have the option to contact the school to request a subsidy, which will be kept confidential. Parent Engagement

Our school council meets roughly every month. Nomination forms to join the council are sent home with students at the beginning of each school year. Any parent is welcome to attend the meetings. All the meeting minutes are posted to our school website.
