Remembrance Day was observed at Lawfield School on November 9th with an assembly. The student's behaviour was outstanding and demonstrated a lot of respect and compassion.


Scholastic Book Fair


Special Lunches in November

Winter Weather

Bus cancellations and school closures

How does HWDSB decide on bus cancellations and school closures?

- When bad weather is expected, Hamilton-Wentworth Student Transportation Services (HWSTS) carriers check weather reports, road conditions and road clearing, starting as early as 4 a.m.
- Based on this information, the Director of Education makes the decision in conjunction with Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board.





When do we make decisions?

HWDSB will announce the cancellation of school and board operations by <u>6 am</u> based on the best information at the time.

The HWDSB Rule:

Inclement weather
+ Bus cancellation
= No school

When HWDSB cancels busing due to inclement weather, we have deemed the roads unsafe and this triggers the closure of schools. Some boards have different procedures.

A school cancellation is a tough decision – and some families may disagree with HWDSB's call. Families can always make the choice they feel is best when it comes to sending their child to school.

Email Notifications for Bus Delays

The Parent's Portal tool on the HWSTS website (www.hamiltonschoolbus.ca) enables parents /guardians to create a secure online account where they can access transportation details for their children. The portal also allows account holders to choose to receive email notifications if their child's bus is delayed by more than 10 minutes.

Please note that we are not able to contact the bus company if you cannot meet your child at the bus stop, therefore, please make alternative arrangements in advance if you are running late or stuck in traffic.

JUST A REMINDER FROM THE OFFICE:

If your child is going to be absent or late, please call the school at (905) 387-0062 and leave a message on our 24hr answering machine, stating your child's full name, and the reason for the absence. Please also <u>spell</u> your child's name and give the name of your child's teacher.

If your child is being picked up early for an appointment or is not going home on the bus, please send a note to the teacher so the teacher is aware. Last minute calls and changes may not always be possible for the office to get the message to the student. If your child attends the after school program, you need to contact them directly to let them know they will not be attending.

Can you please also submit a note to the office, in writing, if you will be going away on vacation stating the dates and names of your children as we need it for auditing purposes.

French Immersion Application

HWDSB uses an application process for entry into French Immersion for children born in 2013.

A Grade 1 system-wide application process for entry to French Immersion allows for program placement of students, monitoring of accommodations, balance of enrolment, and long-term stability of the French Immersion program.

We guarantee an offer of placement in the program (not a specific school) to all applicants. Please take note of the important dates:

Friday, October 19, 2018	Application process opens for Senior Kindergarten students
Friday, November 30, 2018	Deadline for applications
Friday, December 14, 2018	Program location offered to Parent/Guardian
Monday, January 14, 2019	Deadline for program acceptance and registration

Please note: Families with an older sibling currently in French Immersion are still required to complete an online application for the new student.
