

2019-2020 Class Placements

We make every effort to place students in classes where they will have the greatest opportunities for success. Both teacher and parent input into placement decisions is welcomed.

Each June, we meet with teachers to build classes for the following year. Keeping a balance of gender, ability, and learning styles in a classroom is not always easy. When teachers meet with us to build classes, they provide information about student learning and contribute to the decision-making process. This is not an easy process. When requests for class changes are made at a later date, they can be very difficult and often impossible to accommodate as moving one student mid-year has a domino effect upon the placement of other students.

Parents should submit written requests (clacroix@hwdsb.on.ca) for class placement no later than May 31st. Although we shall try to honour these requests, it is not always possible to do so.

SafeArrival

With SafeArrival, families report a child's absence in one of three ways:



Use the SafeArrival website, go.schoolmessenger.ca. The first time you use the website, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.



Using your mobile device, download and install the SchoolMessenger app from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store (or from links at go.schoolmessenger.ca). The first time you use the app, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.



Call the toll-free number 844-506-4350 to report an absence using the automated phone system. These options are available 24 hours/day, seven days a week. You can report a future absence any time.
