



Kindergarten Registration Opened February 3rd

If your child is four or turning four before December 31st, you may register him/her for Kindergarten. Please register online at http://www.hwdsb.on.ca/kindergarten/ and our office administrator will call you to make an appointment once we receive your application from the Board. Appointments will be booked Monday to Friday between 9:30-11:30 and 1:30-3:00. If you are not available during those times, we will do our best to accommodate your needs. You will need to provide proof of address(tenancy agreement or proof of purchase of home); birth certificate and health card. All immunization records will need to be given to Public Health directly by the parents.
