Please make special note that:

- Student costumes must be able to accommodate a face mask/covering as per COVID requirements and will be expected to wear these face masks as per HWDSB Covid-19 Protocols throughout the day.
- Student Costumes must be appropriate for school and must not include any weapons, must not impede vision, and must not contain any inappropriate images, etc.
- There will be no sharing of treats/items between students allowed in any way on this day as per Covid-19 Protocols.
- Students will not be engaging in any types of parades/visits to other classrooms as per Covid-19 protocols.
- Students and Staff will maintain safe practices including physical distancing and hand hygiene throughout this day as per HWDSB/Public Health Protocols.
