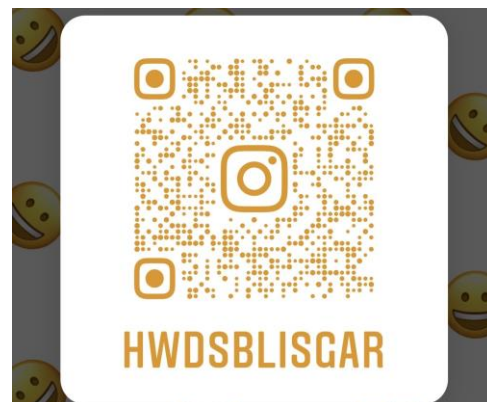


Snow Clearing at Lisgar
