
#### **COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT**


- •40 hours of community involvement must be completed as part of each student's graduation requirements

- supports student's career explorations and reinforces importance of volunteering



#### **ONTARIO SECONDARY SCHOOL LITERACTY TEST**

- administered during Grade 10 year
- based on expectations for language and communication up to and including Grade 9
- accommodations for ESL students and students with an IEPcontent may not be altered
- a deferral may be granted
- exemptions for students not working toward a secondary school diploma

- 110 hours/credit required
- Requires application and interview
- System Placements

    - Require interview and additional application
- System Programs
  - ArtSmart, Building Careers from the Ground Up, Caring for Our Future (Healthcare), Growing Careers (Horticulture), Limeridge Community Co-op, Military Co-op, Ontario Public Service
  - Require interview and additional application



#### **ONTARIO YOUTH APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM**

- Start your chosen career and train as a registered apprentice while enrolled in high school
- On the job training for students who like to learn by doing
- Signed apprentice = Paid employment + 4 credits + apprenticeship hours
- Over 130 careers including Early Childhood Educator, Chef, Carpenter, Electrician, Hairstylist etc.

#### **ELEARNING OPTIONS**


- There are over 100 elearning options being offered for the 2019/2020 school year






