Blessed with a dedicated staff, MacNab students have the opportunity to participate in a broad array of field trips, sports, and clubs.

MacNab Recreation Centre, attached to the school, also allows our students to participate in aquatic studies and extracurricular teams such as Boys' and Girls' Water Polo teams.
