Ineligible Activities

The Ministry of Education has developed a list of activities that may **not** be chosen as community involvement activities. These are referred to as ineligible activities, some of which are as follows.

An ineligible activity is an activity that: -



1. is the requirement of a class or course in which the student is enrolled (e.g., cooperative education portion of a course, job shadowing, work experience);



2. would normally be performed for wages by a person in the workplace;



3. takes place during the time allotted for the instructional program on a school day. However, an activity that takes place during the student's lunch breaks or "spare" periods is permissible;



4. consists of duties normally performed in the home (i.e., daily chores) or personal recreational activities.
