MacNab Student Nomination Process

The Shulich Leader Scholarship is competitive as only one student from MacNab will be nominated for this opportunity. MacNab has established a process for students who wish to earn the nomination. Student candidates must be in their final academic year of high school and be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident of Canada. Candidates must provide proof that they plan to enroll in an eligible STEM program at one or more of the 20 partner Universities. Students who are planning a career as a medical practitioner or in medical research are not eligible for the selection process. This includes; doctors, dentists, nurses, psychologists, pharmacists, optometrists, etc. This scholarship is for entrepreneurial-minded innovators outside of the medical community. Candidates must possess at least two of the following three attributes:

- 1. academic excellence;
- demonstration of leadership in school-life or community-life or provided evidence of entrepreneurial talent; or
- 3. financial need

Potential candidates must write a 600 word rationale (maximum word count) which addresses why they should win the nomination. Students should align their personal rationale to the requirements of the Shulich Leader Scholarship (found through on-line research).
