

Black Youth Mentorship Program – MacNab Consent to Participate

Dear Parent or Guardian,

What will happen?

With your permission, your child will participate in the Black Youth Mentorship Program by attending monthly sessions between November 2020 and June 2021 as outlined in the program description. Sessions will be approximately 60 minutes in length and take place after school. Students will participate online from home or at school. Due to public health restrictions, all sessions will be virtual and hosted on HWDSB's Microsoft Teams platform. Sessions will be facilitated Samson Dekamo, HCCI Program Coordinator and/or guest facilitators based on the session topics. Sessions will also be supported by Sir Allan MacNab S.S. staff advisors, Seema Narula and Kelly Davy.

Are there risks?

Some of the content of the sessions and ensuing discussion may elicit strong feelings and emotions. Students need to be in satisfactory physical and mental condition to safely participate in the program.

Will personal information be collected?

Yes, with your explicit consent and if students agree, during the sessions, HCCI and HWDSB leaders may take photographs to commemorate student participation in the program. Pictures along with student names may be shared on social media, HWDSB and HCCI websites, they may be used for broadcasting on television or radio, and in brochures or other print materials that promote and celebrate the BYMP program. HCCI will not use the photographs to promote other programs outside the Black Youth Mentorship Program. All photographs will be destroyed once the program is over for the year and any print and electronic materials have been created.

Can your child still participate in the program if you do not want personal information shared?

Yes, absolutely. It is okay if you do not want images of your child released. Your child can still fully participate in the program. If you consent now but change your mind later, we will destroy all images that we have captured up until that point and will no longer post any images, etc., online for the remainder of the program. However, anything that has already been posted online or released publicly in other formats will be outside of our control to remove.
