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## CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENTS

**The Ontario Secondary School Certificate is a pathway for some students and can also be granted on request to students who leave school before earning the Ontario Secondary School Diploma. The requirements for an OSSC are:**

### **Compulsory Credits (total of 7)**

- 2 credits in English
- 1 credit in Mathematics
- 1 credit in Science
- 1 credit in Canadian History OR Canadian Geography
- 1 credit in Health and Physical Education
- 1 credit in the Arts OR Technological Education
