The goal is to develop criteria to help us decide if guests in schools are sharing content that is safe and inclusive for students. A consistent approach will help HWDSB ensure all students are safe, supported and included in educational spaces. This will help us eliminate discriminatory biases and support equity, student achievement and well-being.
