Admission Requirements

Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD), or equivalent including the following required course(s):

- ✓ English any Grade 12 (C) or (U), or equivalent
- ✓ Biology Grade 11 (C) or (U) or Grade 12 (U)
- Chemistry Grade 11 (U) or Grade 12 (C) or (U) OR Physics – Grade 11 (U) or Grade 12 (C) or (U)

Recommended Courses and/or Skills:

Selection and Ranking

For competitive programs—where the number of qualified applicants exceeds the available places—selection will be based on the most senior level final grade available in required courses at the time of ranking. Mid-term grades are not used for ranking purposes. Testing or other supplemental evaluation may be required.


Pre-Admission Requirements

- ✓ Pre-admission testing Completion of the Health Occupations Aptitude Exam (HOAE)
- A full Class G driver's licence is required by August 1st, 2021


